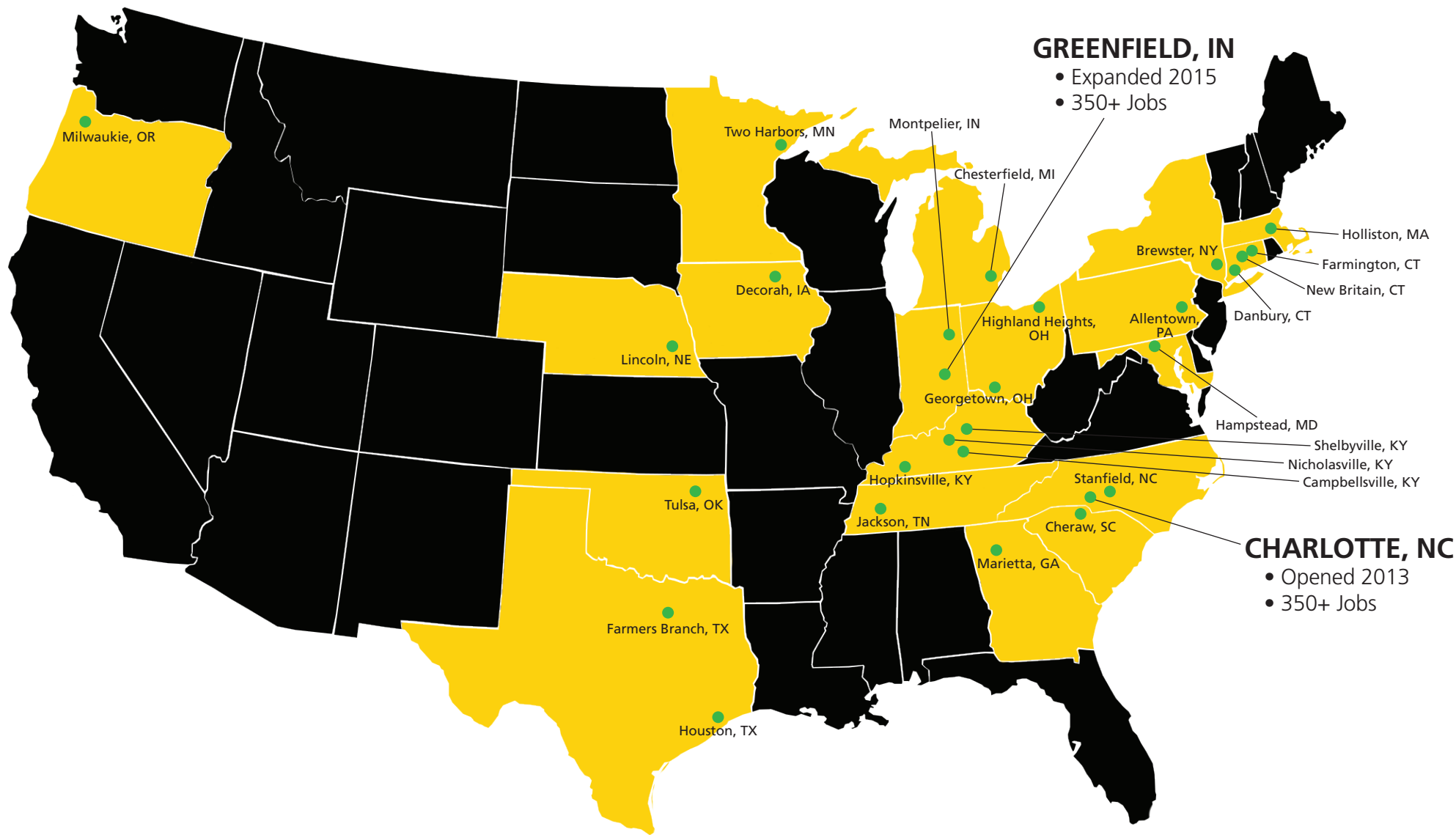

## BUILDING ON A LEGACY

Manufacturing in the U.S. is nothing new to Stanley Black & Decker. We have made products in the U.S. since our founding almost 175 years ago, and our current U.S. manufacturing footprint still includes our tape measure plant in New Britain, Connecticut, where our headquarters are located. In addition to our global facilities, we operate close to 30 plants in the U.S. today, including 11 in our tools and storage business that employ some 3,000 employees. In fact, we have increased U.S. tools manufacturing jobs by 40% over the last three years.

While manufacturing in the U.S. is not always an obvious choice to some, it makes good business sense for us. We know our end users generally like to buy products made in their own countries, especially professionals in the trades. Our make where we sell strategy improves logistics and distribution, as well as environmental impact. We already manufacture many products cost effectively in the U.S., and in some cases, we've been able to bring manufacturing back to the U.S. at a lower cost than producing overseas.
